

Jungle Bus Updated Policies and Procedures:

Although cleaning protocols have always been important, we have increased the amount of routine cleaning with a focus on high-touch surfaces and common areas using cleaning products that meet all CDC guidelines.

Below are our new safety and cleaning guidelines due to COVID 19:

1. Preparing the Jungle Bus

- We have stocked the Jungle Bus with mats and other equipment that can be easily cleaned and disinfected between each class.
- All stuffed animals have been removed from the Jungle Bus.
- We have replaced our Jungle Bus rope with a plastic rope (which can be easily cleaned and disinfected between classes).
- We have removed the ball pit from the Jungle Bus.

2. Preparing Employees

- All employees must have their temperatures checked twice a day. Once when they arrive at the Jungle Bus and once at lunch time. Temperatures will be recorded on the Employee daily safety checklist. All employees will also do symptom screening questions daily & record.
- Jungle Bus employees will wear face masks when entering childcare centers and each classroom.

3. Jungle Bus classes

- We will only be taking students from only one age group per Jungle Bus 30 minute class.
- Small groups to allow for social distancing.
- Students will use hand sanitizer before entering, and after exiting the Jungle Bus. Students will also wash their hands again upon entering their classroom.
- Due to limited space and social distancing guidelines, parents will not be able to observe classes.
- If a student misses a regular class at their center, they can access a makeup class recorded on Zoom. Details to follow.

4. Increased Cleaning & Disinfectant

- Equipment will be sprayed with disinfectant and allowed to air dry every morning and several times throughout the day.
- Interior of Jungle Bus will be cleaned, sanitized & disinfected between each group of children and at the end of each teaching day.
- Jungle Bus will only be traveling to one center per day at this time to allow enough time to thoroughly clean between each center.

5. Illness Policy

- Any Jungle Bus employee having a fever of 100.4 or higher or any COVID symptoms will be sent home immediately and will not return until cleared by doctor
- Any student showing any signs of illness will be taken back into childcare center and then follow the childcare center's protocols for illness.
- If a Jungle Bus employee or a Jungle Bus student does test positive for COVID 19, the Jungle Bus will be closed immediately for 3 days for deep cleaning and disinfecting, and the FLDOH will be notified.

6. Contactless Correspondence

- Jungle Bus payment will now be contactless. Parents will have the choice to mail in their payments or pay through the parent portal on the Jungle Bus website.
- Weekly notes will be emailed to parents with details about the class for that week on Jungle Bus.
